

Your initial appointment will consist of a consultation explaining your diagnosis and treatment options. Please assist us by providing the following information at the time of your consultation:

- Surgical referral slip and any x-rays if applicable
- Bring proof of dental insurance.
- If you have medical or dental insurance, bring necessary completed forms.
This will save time and allow us to help you process any claims.

Important: All patients under the age of 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at the consultation visit and surgery. A preoperative consultation and physical examination is mandatory for patients undergoing IV anesthesia. The night before surgery you can not have anything to eat or drink after midnight. You will also need an adult to drive you home. Please alert the office if you have a medical condition that may be of concern prior to surgery (i.e. diabetes, high blood pressure, artificial heart valves and joints, rheumatic fever, etc.) or if you are on any medication such as heart medications, aspirin, and anticoagulant therapy.

X-Rays

If your dentist or physician has taken x-rays, you can request that they forward them to our office. If they are not sent to our office you will need to pick them up so they are available at the time of your consultation. If additional films are necessary, they can be taken at our facility.

Financial Information

Please remember you are fully responsible for all fees charged by this office regardless of your insurance coverage.
